ERC Funding Instruments

General conditions: All fields of science and scholarship are eligible

- investigator-driven, bottom-up

Excellence is the only valid criterion

Flexible grants, up to five years

Independent individuals in Europe

- nationality of researchers is not relevant

- host organisation to be located in EU or AS

Starting Grants: 2 to 9 years after PhD

~ 500,000 - 2,000,000 Euro per Grant

~ 300 Starting Grants per year


Advanced Grants: Benchmarks of 10 year "track record"

~ 2,500,000 Euro per grant

~ 400 Advanced Grants per year



ERC Annual Budget Evolution 2007 - 2013: Total 7.51 BN €






ERC Starting Grants: Two stage evaluation process

Stage 1 evaluation: ~ 6 % "GO" rate 8794 **Stage 2 evaluation:** proposals ~ 54% success rate evaluated **Interviews 559** stage 2 "GO" proposals 300 anticipated Grants Requested Budget Requested Budget Awarded Budget about 10 B€ about 535 M€ about 300 M€


