


Postdoc Qualification and Career Development


Abstract


DKFZ hosts more than 300 postdocs who contribute to our high impact research programs. Postdocs are encouraged to prepare themselves for the next step in their careers. This is supported by the DKFZ Management Board through several instruments. (1) Compulsory yearly appraisal interviews including career plan discussions to be held with supervisors (2) mentoring programs (3) advanced training offers including a Postdoc Qualification Program (4) career Service including one-to-one career guidance (5) the postdoc network@dkfz (PDN) etc. By taking advantage of these offers, postdocs can expand their skills, improve their qualifications, increase their visibility and broaden their options to make informed career decisions.








Outlook

DKFZ postdocs are strongly encouraged to take ownership of their personal career development. Yet many postdocs wish for more flexibility with respect to the time frame granted for career building. They wish for more transparency regarding academic positions in academia beyond professorships. Creating more opportunities in academia is a prerequisite to ensure attracting the best scientists of each coming generation to academia. In addition, a further harmonization of the european workspace will be necessary to ensure and enhance mobility. Research institutes and higher education institutes can also benefit from implementing career development plans to better prepare postdocs for future tasks, for example in science management.


